Meet with your caterers	Purchase the rings
Reserve a block of hotel rooms for out-of-town guests	Finalise the event schedule and start creating timeline
Create a registry and include this information	Print programs

Book your celebrant	Meet with your officiant and go over the ceremony outline
6-7 MONTHS BEFORE	2 MONTHS BEFORE
Purchase your invitations	Meet with your photographer to discuss day-of plans along
Finalise your guest list and request addresses	with any specific family portraits/couple portraits you want
Start planning your honeymoon	Review the music playlist with the band and dj
Choose bridesmaid dresses	Send out invitations
Reserve rentals (tents, linens, chairs, tables, lighting, etc.)	Submit your announcement to the local newspaper
Book your florist	Let loose at your bachelor/bachelorette parties
Book your hair and makeup artists	Send out as many final payments as you can
Arrange transportation for the night	Touch base with all vendors
Send out save-the-date cards	Make sure groomsmen attire has been purchased/rented

Wedding Planning CHECKLIST



1 MONTH BEFORE	DAY OF WEDDING
Get your marriage license Attend your last dress fitting	Make sure you have a good breakfast, and plan snacks for during the day while you are getting ready
Send out rehearsal-dinner invitations Purchase alcohol and finalise signature cocktails	Nominate someone to deal with any last minute questions from wedding vendors
if needed	Get someone with a loud voice and great organisational
Confirm arrival and departure times for all vendors and send out your day-of-timeline to vendors	skills to corral people for the family photos
Create your seating chart for the reception, if needed	TIPS FOR GREAT WEDDING PHOTOS
☐ Purchase wedding party gifts☐ Write your vows☐ Enter all rsvps you have received into your guest list	Try and choose a light and airy place to get ready (boys and girls) and keep the mess out of the rooms you'll be getting ready (and photographed) in
Check on hotel room bookings Call guests who have not rsvp'd for final head count	Consider ordering a spare buttonhole for the groom, in case his gets squashed during hugs and congrats.
Make sure members of the wedding party know their roles and duties come the wedding day	Bring wet wipes for getting the guests make up off the grooms shoulder!
1 WEEK BEFORE	Think carefully about where you position your wedding cake, try and choose an attractive background with good natural light
Touch base with all vendors one last time	Allocate 10-15 minutes around dessert time for a sneaky
Outsource any small day-of tasks to friends and family	sunset portrait session, you wont regret it!
Ensure everyone in your family and wedding party has your day-of timeline	AFTER WEDDING
De-stress and do something fun and relaxing (Spa day? Hiking?)	Pay any remaining balances to vendors
Send the final guest list to the caterer	Clean and preserve your wedding gown
Have extra checks ready for day-of payments	Enjoy your honeymoon!!!
Dance around in your wedding shoes to break them in	Write "thank you" cards
Pack for your honeymoon	Officially change your name (this is totally optional!)
Go on one last date night with your partner before the big day	Complete your registry Order prints and albums from your photographer
